is the most produced and consumed vegetable oil in the world



Palm oil comes from the fruit of the oil palm tree

Almost 60% of African great ape habitat overlaps with current oil palm plantations



And 40 % of that habitat overlaps with unprotected land suitable for oil palm production

Oil palm currently covers 7.8
million hectares of land in
West and Central Africa
Another I million have been
approved for development









That's the same as 5.8 million soccer fields

Most palm oil is produced in Malaysia and Indonesia



But producers are now expanding operations into West and Central Africa

Palm oil production in
Southeast Asia is linked to
deforestation, loss of
biodiversity, climate change,
and human rights violations



African producers need to adopt sustainable and ethical practices now to avoid the same mistakes



Such as vegetable oil, palmitate, palmitic acid and sodium lauryl sulfate
